the light is On automatically when the motion sensor senses people in the toilet <u>cubicle</u>




the light intensity can be adjusted via a dimmer on the light to suit different needs



the light is also designed as an emergency signaling device to fence off intruders



by swingling the light (like a pendulum), a swinging lighting effect can be created



the swinging lighting effect as an emergency signal calling for help





intruder is approaching



grab the O-shaped ring






swing the light

couple with the sound given off by the emergency alarm system, the intruder will most likely move away as people are alerted about his presence




power source (solar panel)




with the light On, one can tell whether the toilet cubicle is in use. the swinging lighting effect during emergency is highly noticeable


